CMFNH Program Overview



- PG&E 2006-08 New Construction Multifamily Program implemented by HMG
- Similar to previous RNC MF PG&E offering plus
 - → Design assistance
 - → HERS Rater Incentives
 - → Energy Consultant Incentives
- Two program components for both High-rise and Low-rise
 - → Performance: Exceed T-24 by 15% for Multiple Incentives
 - → Appliances: Individual Measure Incentives





Program Benefits





- Financial Incentives: At least 15% above T-24
 - → \$150-\$200/unit Developer Incentive
 - → \$60/unit HERS Rater Incentive
 - → \$50/unit Energy Consultant Incentive
 - → Appliance Incentives
- Design Assistance
 - → Technical Support
- Qualify for other Programs
 - → New Solar Homes Program (CEC)
 - → ENERGY STAR® New Homes (EPA)
 - → LEED for Homes (USGBC)

CMFNH Performance Program Requirements

- New construction (3 or more dwelling units/bldg)
- Exceed 2005 Title 24 part 6 by at least 15%
- Positive electric energy savings
- Served by PG&E (gas or electric)
- Passes plan review and viability checks
- Third-party (HERS rater) verification
- Completion within 30 months of signing the application



Performance Approach

- T-24 Performance Approach considers
 - → Building Envelope:
 - Orientation, Insulation, Windows, Assemblies
 - → HVAC:
 - Heating and Cooling equipment and distribution
 - → DHW:
 - Central and individual water heating equipment & distribution
- CEC-certified software programs must demonstrate at least 15% > T-24 and positive electric energy savings
 - → EnergyPro (Low rise and High rise)
 - → MICROPAS (Low rise only)
- Applies to dwelling units only, not common areas or nonresidential portion of mixed use



At least 15% > 2005 code



- Compliance Margin / Standard Design
- Negative Electric Energy: <u>Does not comply</u>



High-Rise Title 24 PERF-1: Code Compliance vs Program Compliance




- Subtract
 - → Lighting
 - → Receptacle
- Divide
 - → Margin/Standard

13.73/63.62 = 21.58%
